


ZHUANG HONG YI

Born in Sichuan, China and having spent the last 25 years in Rotterdam, Zhuang has over 30 international solo exhibitions as well as being featured in many Contemporary art museums and major art fairs.

Zhuang Hong Yi's work includes striking flowerbed designs and opulent wall installations made from fine rice paper and acrylic. His intricate artwork combines flavours from the East and West, paying homage to both Chinese tradition and Europe's impressionist movement.

Throughout the years, Zhuang has gained a reputation as an artist whose work is increasingly popular among royals and celebrities. Some of his known collectors include the King of Morocco, the Abu Dhabi royal family, Saudi and Qatari royalty as well as many Hollywood celebrities.




No.6 by Zhuang Hong Yi 90 x 70


